The Miss Beautiful SMTX and You(th) Can Do It! Pageants are being held in conjunction on April 24, 2020 at Hernandez Elementary School. There is a \$10 entry fee for youth to participate and a \$25 entry fee for adults to participate. SMCISD students do not have to pay an entry fee. Contestants do not have to reside in San Marcos.

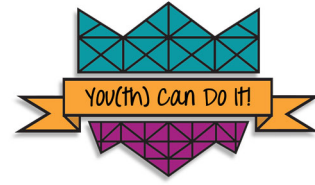
Youth prizes will be awarded for Queen/King and First, Second, and Third Runner Up in the following categories: Little Miss Beautiful SMTX, Jr. Miss Beautiful SMTX, Little Mr. San Marvelous, and Jr. Mr. San Marvelous. Awards will also be given for Most Expressive and Most Inspirational. "Little" contestants are ages 4-12. "Junior" contestants are ages 13-17. Adult prizes will be awarded for Queen/Miss Beautiful SMTX and First, Second, Third Runner Up, Most Expressive, and Most Inspirational for female contestants ages 18 and up.

During the pageant, contestants will have to answer a short question that will be provided two weeks prior to the event. For youth, there will be one semi-formal runway look and an optional talent showcase. For adults, there will be a beachwear look, a formal runway look, and an optional talent showcase. Adult contestants are **not** required to wear a swimsuit for the beachwear look.

The purpose of this pageant is to provide youth and adults with special needs an opportunity to build confidence and practice self-expression.

Pageant Information

- Youth pageant entry fee is \$10 and Adult pageant entry fee is \$25. Entry fees are due at the time of application submission. SMCISD students do not have to pay an entry fee. Entry fee is non-refundable. A 5"x7" headshot is also due at time of application submission. Space is limited to the first 25 boys, 25 girls, and 25 adults. Payment may be made via check to City of San Marcos or via credit card at 401 E. Hopkins, San Marcos, TX 78666.
- Contestants are responsible for providing their own appropriate semi-formal look and outfit for the optional talent showcase. A selection of donated clothing may be available. Contestants are responsible for their own hair and makeup. Cosmetology students will be on hand for touch-ups. There will be a dressing room for boys, a dressing room for girls, and a dressing room for the adult females.
- The contestants will be asked a question during the competition. The question will be provided to contestants two weeks prior to the pageant. Contestants may respond verbally, with a storyboard, or however they wish to express themselves.

Pageant Rules

- Good sportsmanship is required at all times by contestants, parents and guests. Bad sportsmanship is NEVER tolerated. If any contestant, guardian, or guest violates our sportsmanship rules at any time, they will be DISQUALIFIED. Any awards received will be forfeited and they will be asked to leave immediately with no refund. EVERYONE who comes to our pageants has the right to be treated with kindness and respect! **THIS APPLIES TO WORDS OR ACTIONS BEFORE, DURING, OR AFTER THE PAGEANT!**
- Contestant agrees to participate in a run through the day before the pageant on April 23 at 7pm. Those who do not attend the dress rehearsal will not be allowed to participate.
- All contestants must remain until crowning in order to receive prizes. Any contestant that leaves before crowning forfeits their prizes and no refund will be given.
- Youth prizes will be awarded for Queen/King and First, Second, and Third Runner Up in the following categories: Little Miss Beautiful SMTX, Jr. Miss Beautiful SMTX, Little Mr. San Marvelous, and Jr. Mr. San Marvelous. Awards will also be given for Most Expressive and Most Inspirational. "Little" contestants are ages 4-12. "Junior" contestants are ages 13-17. Adult prizes will be awarded for Queen/Miss Beautiful SMTX and First, Second, Third Runner Up, Most Expressive, and Most Inspirational for contestants ages 18 and up.
- No one will be allowed backstage on the date of the pageant other than pageant officials, contestants, approved guardian, and others approved by the director to assist the contestants with preparations. All individuals backstage will have appropriate credentials or arm bands. No men/boys will be allowed in the female dressing rooms and no females/girls will be allowed in the boys dressing room. Should your guardian be the opposite gender, please make arrangements for the same gender to assist in the dressing room.
- **All decisions of the judges are final.** Do not approach the judges before, during or after the pageant. It is okay to speak with the judges if they approach you. Judges will be people who are not directly affiliated with contestants entering the pageants.
- No information will be given out about the contestant groups or the judges until the day of the pageant.

- Contestants and guests will not be permitted to drink alcoholic beverages, smoke, or use foul language at any time during the pageant and must follow all school rules.
- Contestants and their parents/guardians agree to hold harmless all persons affiliated with the City of San Marcos and San Marcos Consolidated School District, in case of any loss or injury occurring during the entire pageant and preparation for the pageant.
- Contestants and their parents / guardians agree that the City of San Marcos and San Marcos Consolidated School District may publish any photographs taken at an official event or submitted by the contestant, contestant name, and likeness for use in the organization's print, online (including social media) and video-based marketing materials, as well as other organization publications. Winners also agree to ride on the Keep San Marcos Beautiful float in the Veterans Day Parade on November 7, 2020 and assist with handing out awards at the Keep San Marcos Beautiful Awards Ceremony in Spring 2021.
