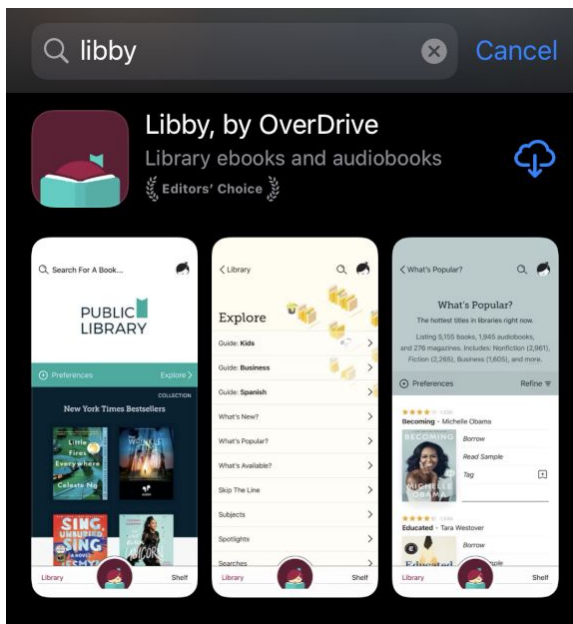




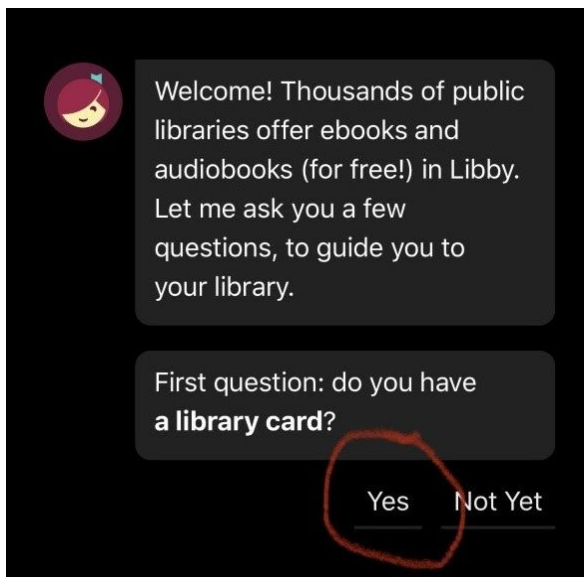

### Accessing eBooks via Libby App

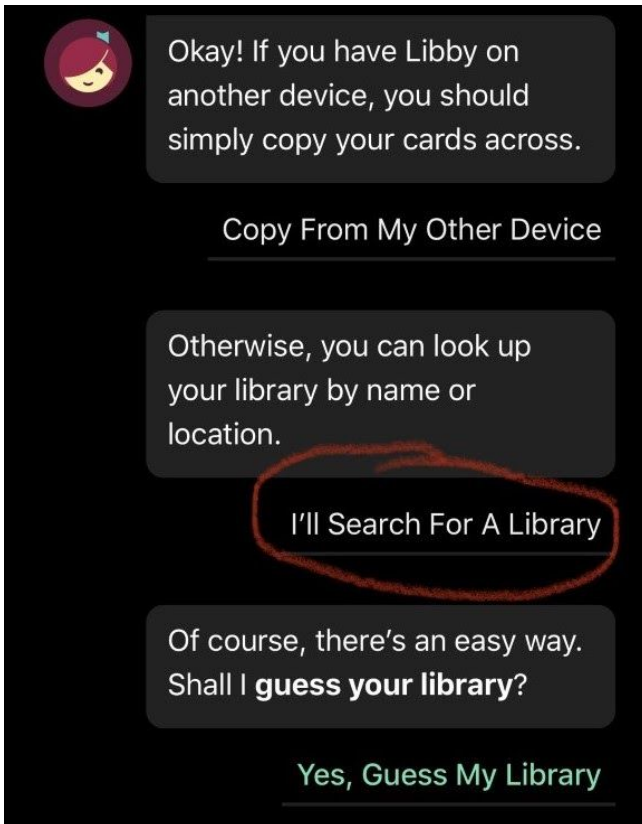
1. Go to your app store and search for Libby. Download "Libby, by OverDrive."



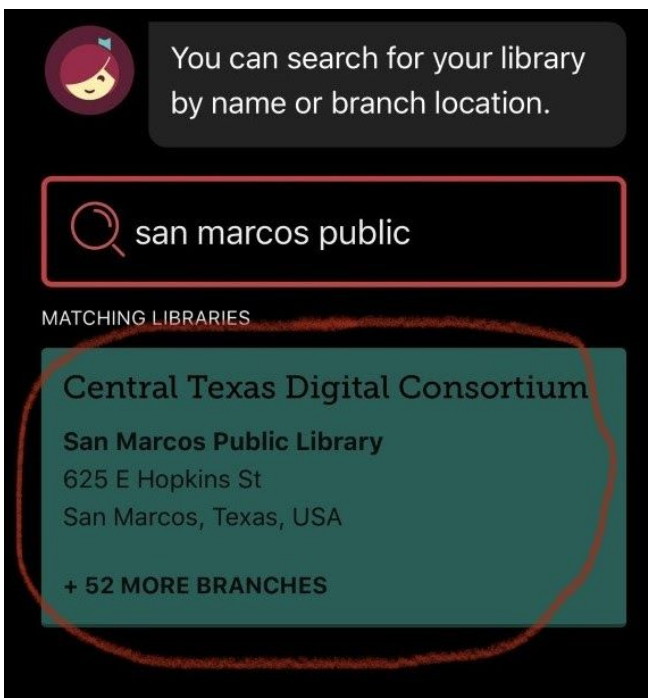
2. Open Libby. This screen will come up. Select yes.



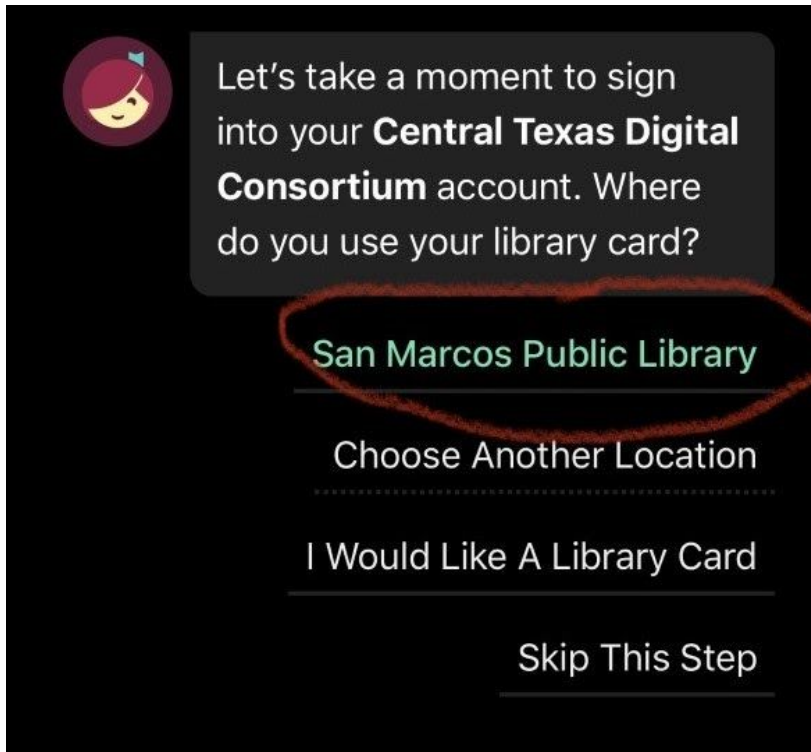
3. Select "I'll Search For A Library."



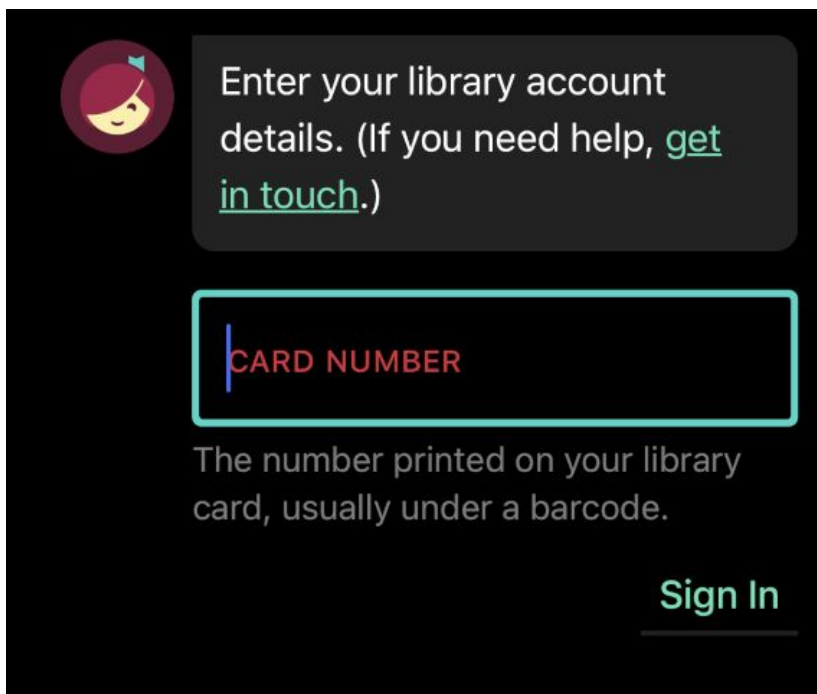
4. Type in San Marcos Public Library, and then select "Central Texas Digital Consortium" with SMPL's info listed below.



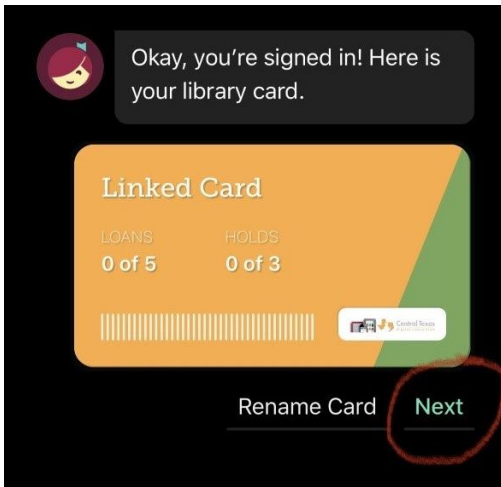
5. Select "San Marcos Public Library."



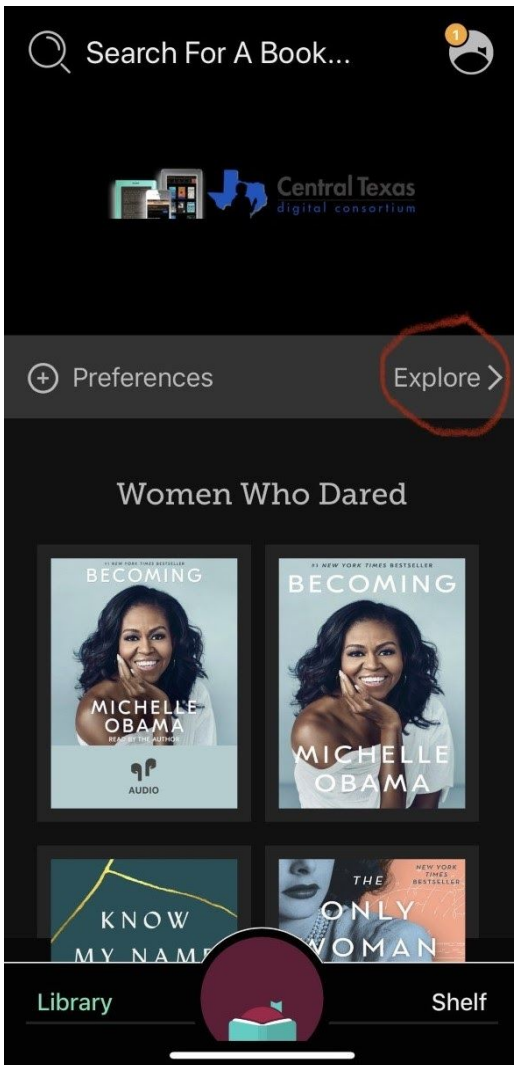
6. Enter your library card number.



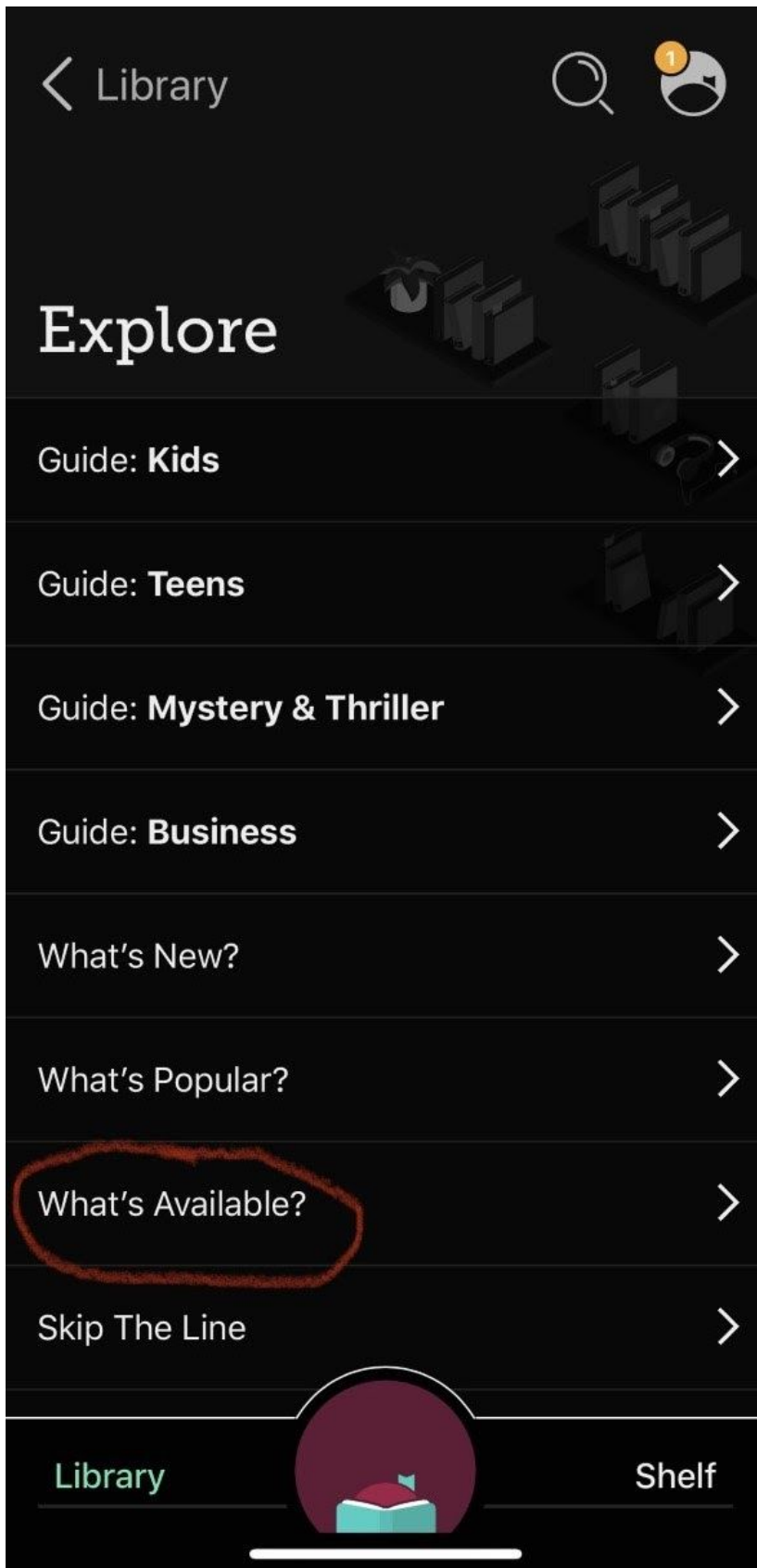
7. Click next.



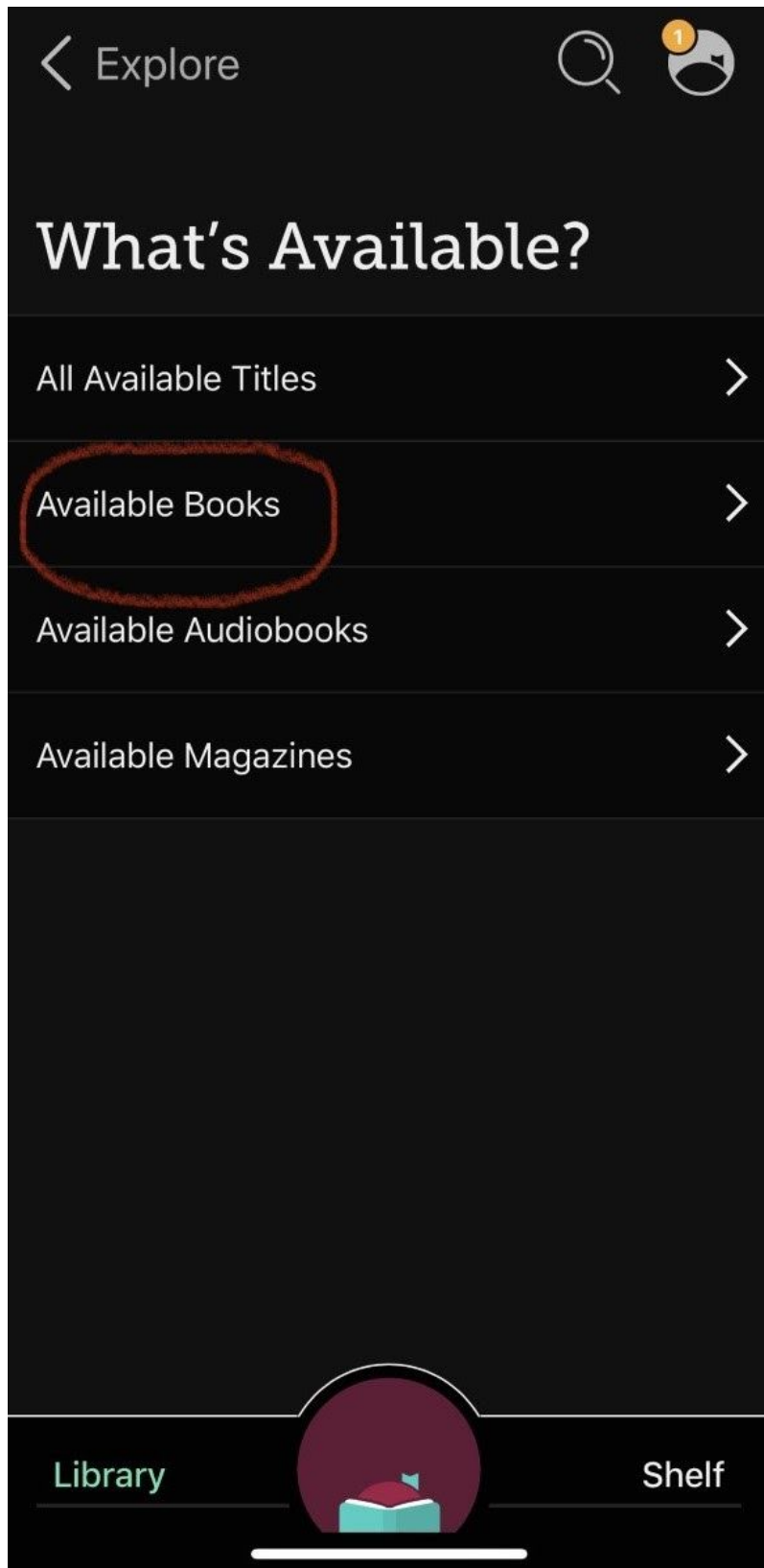
8. From here you can search for a specific title in the search bar at the top. Or you can click "Explore" to search for available books.

10. Select "Available Books."




11. Scroll through the list and once you find a book you would like to borrow select "borrow."



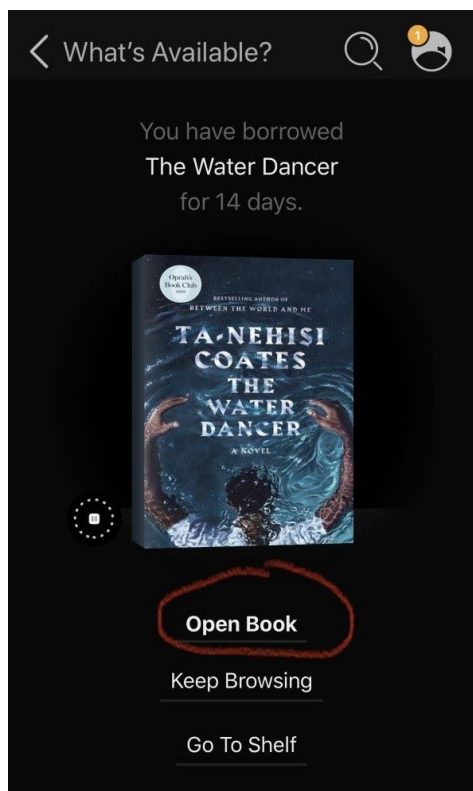

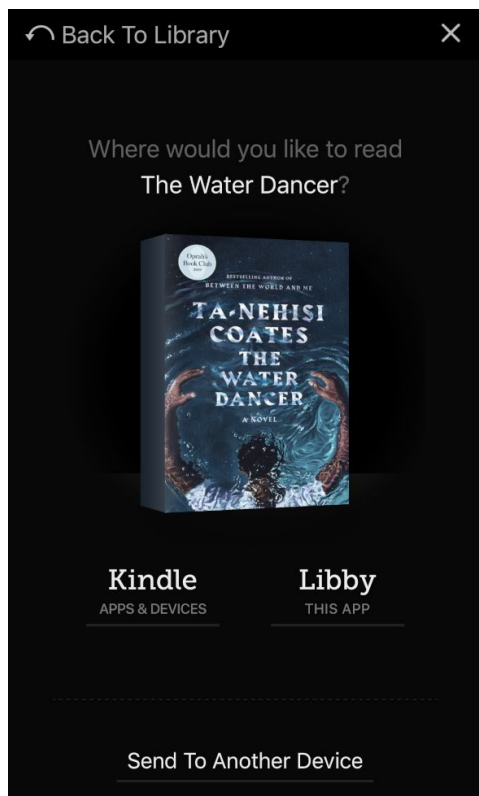


**Library**  **Shelf**

12. Click "Open Book."

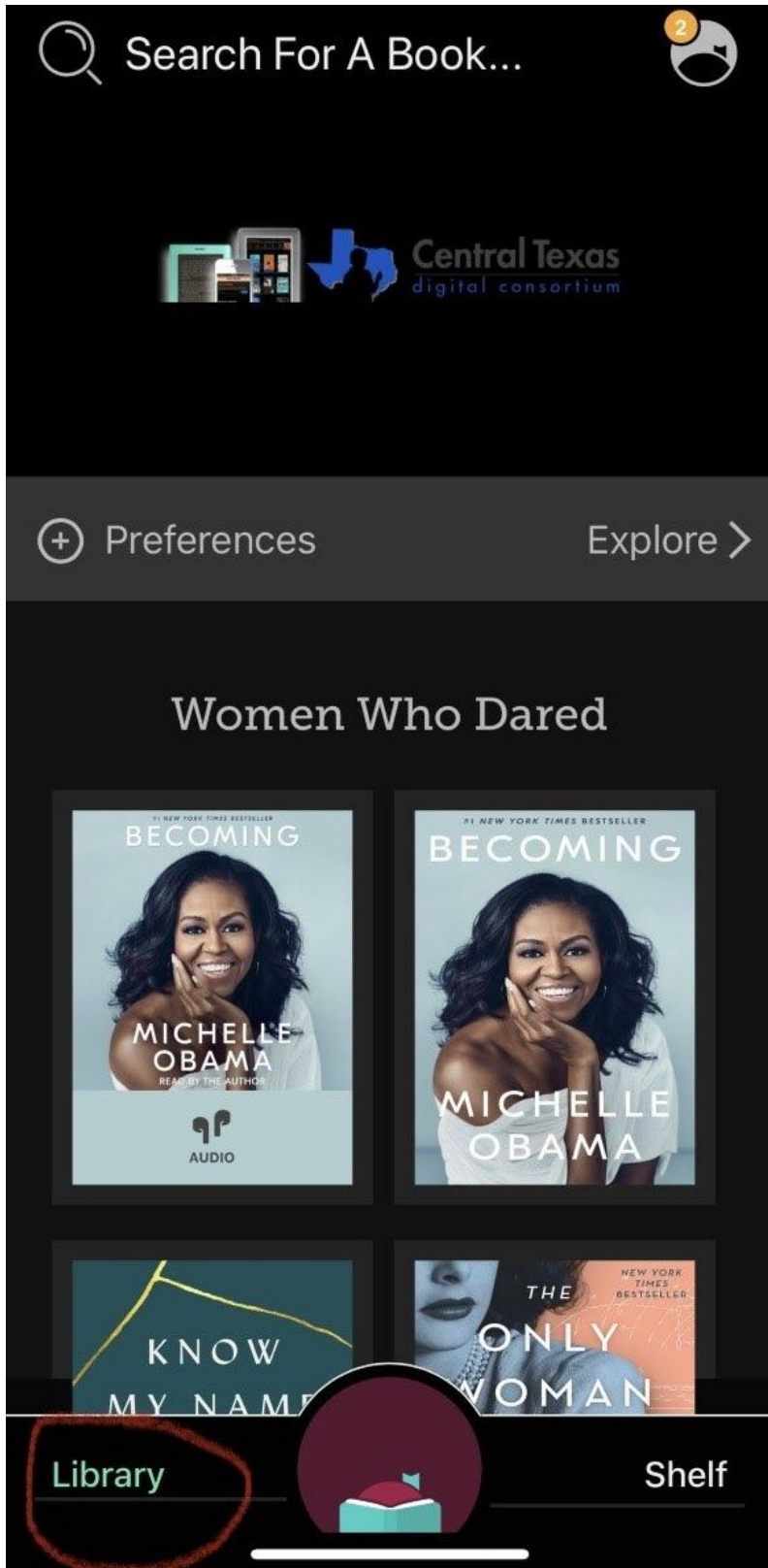


13. Then you can send the eBook to your Kindle or other device or read it directly in the Libby app.





14. When you reopen the app at a later time, your two main screens are either "Library" or "Shelf." At the library screen you can browse and search for eBooks.



15. The "Shelf" screen will show you what items you have already checked out and this is where you would go to read those titles in the Libby app.
