### INFORMATION FOR TENANTS AND LANDLORDS

The federal moratorium on evictions has been extended until January 31, 2021. The moratorium requires tenants to provide a declaration to landlords. The federal CARES Act requires that landlords provide a 30 days notice. Texas State Law requires that the landlord follow specific steps.
