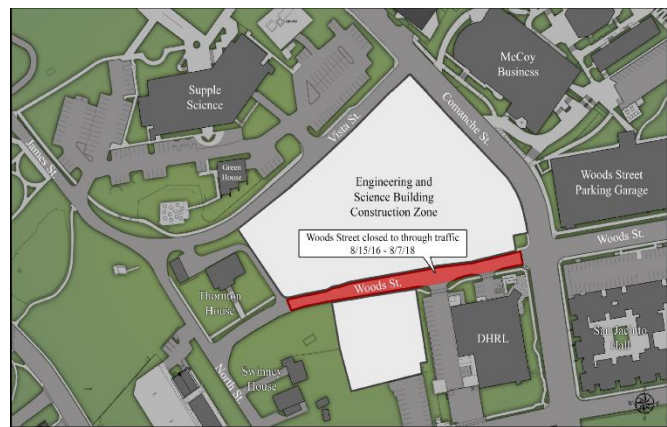
Traffic Update

WOODS ST: A segment of Woods St between Comanche and North Street will be closed during construction of the new Texas State University Engineering & Science Building until August 2018. Project Manager Scott Rouse, 512.245.2202.

COMANCHE: Southbound Comanche between Lindsey and Pat Garrison will close on Monday, Nov. 7 and Nov. 11 from 7 a.m. – 2 p.m. for construction maintenance. Be aware of flaggers. Skyline builders/Matthew Ostrowski, 512.699.6465

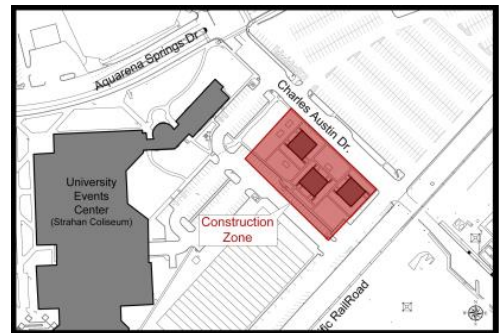
100 S. LBJ: Imagine Alley, located off of the 100 block of S. LBJ will be closed for a Wine and Wassail Walk event on Friday, Nov. 11 from 5 p.m. – 9 p.m. City of San Marcos Main Street Program, 512.393.8430
