The application process you will participate in is designed to provide the information needed to reasonably ensure that our volunteers are deserving of public trust.

All applicants must complete the following steps:

1. Complete Victim Services Volunteer Application.
2. Return completed application. Please note that the "Authority for Release of Information and Waiver" form has to be notarized. **(Without this original form properly notarized, your application cannot be processed.)**
3. A back-ground check will be conducted to verify application information.
4. You will be contacted in reference to eligibility and an appointment will be scheduled for interview. Please allow 1 – 1 ½ hours for the interview process.
5. Upon acceptance, a training start date will be determined. You will be contacted to be photographed for an identification card.
