



IMPORTANT NOTICE

Disabled Veteran Plates and Parking Privileges

As of January 1, 2022, anyone parking in a disabled parking space must have a disabled person license plate or a disabled parking placard that features the International Symbol of Access (ISA). Currently, disabled veteran license plates do not feature the ISA. Texans with disabled veteran license plates wishing to use disabled parking spaces in 2022 may apply for a disabled parking placard or for a new disabled veteran license plate featuring the ISA. The veteran must meet the eligibility requirements for a disabled parking placard or disabled person license plate featuring the ISA. Not all disabilities that qualify a veteran for disabled veteran license plates will qualify a veteran for a disabled veteran license plate featuring the ISA.



DV plates issued without the ISA and are not permitted to parking in disabled parking spaces



New DV Plates with the ISA, and are permitted to park in disabled parking spaces.

You may apply for a disabled parking placard and/or disabled veteran license plates at the office of your local county tax assessor-collector.
